FROM THE PRESIDENT'S DESK

From the president's desk...

By the time this newsletter is published, Field Day 2025 will have come and gone, and the Tennessee summer swelter is upon us. I was reminded recently that there is a strong synergy between station and operator preparedness. The more ready that my station is, the more ready the operator becomes. It works the other way too. If I neglect needed repairs or upgrades, I'm not quite as motivated as I might be for the next contest.

Traditionally, the months between April and September have been considered "off-season" months. Contest types would spend these months getting everything ready in time for the CQWW SSB in October. Then we would try to keep the pedal to the metal through March with the ARRL DX SSB contest.

To some extent, this is still true, but the contest calendar has grown and evolved a great deal over the years. The popularity of RTTY and other digital mode contesting quickly started to fill the calendar. The introduction of CQWW RTTY and WPX RTTY contests turned out to be very popular, bringing in hundreds of new contest enthusiasts per year.

Meanwhile, the WPX CW and SSB contests grew in popularity at a steady rate, and continue to do so. State QSO parties, once a "niche market" for county hunters and advanced mobile operators, have exploded in popularity. Programs such as the State QSO Party Challenge coupled with POTA, SOTA and other "adventure" type operations have brought a great many people into contesting-style operating. The ever-evolving miniaturization of equipment has certainly played a role as well. We should welcome these new operators with open arms.

All of this explosion of "can you hear me now?" activity is good for contesting. There are contests literally every weekend now. Some of the old-timers can be heard occasionally grumbling about "too many contests" diluting the playing field, but I'd much rather have too many contests to choose from than too few.

The Most Radio Active report has been designed to reward those operators who participate in a large number and variety of events. The operators in the top ranks of the MRA report are spreading contesting joy in the most important way -- by making QSOs in lots of events. Let's keep on sowing the seeds of contesting fun.

CORPORATE CASUALS






