The band members gathered here in Pegram a couple of weeks ago and worked up another set of ridiculously silly songs for your entertainment. We are grateful to have N6AN join us this year for our (hopefully) comical version of "The Last Waltz."

Finally, the second biggest CW contest of the year wraps up this month. The WPX CW contest is an "everyone works everyone" contest and is usually a monster rate fest. We're hoping for good band conditions this year, although it is not uncommon for 10 meters to fade a bit at this






### **AD4EB/M – FLORIDA QSO PARTY 2025**

Everything just happened to align perfectly to finally reach the 4,000 QSO mark in this year's FQP. With a QSO count of 1,909 after 10 hours on Saturday, it looked like we would end up a bit short. But we still thought it was possible, as the last few hours operating as a mobile in these QSO parties are often the best (people come out of the woodwork for some reason). To take the most advantage of the last few hours, Melody and I decided to spend a little extra time on 2 county lines, knowing that it would probably cause us to miss making it to our last planned county. It paid off, the QSO counts for the last 3 hours were 230, 252, and 198, which took us barely over 4,000 QSOs for the first time as a single op. Our final claimed QSO count is 4,011 QSOs, which we realize may not stand after log checking, but that's okay as it would give us a goal for next year.

This was the first time I've ever averaged 200 QSOs/hour in a 20-hour contest. Here are the things I feel contributed to making it possible:

- 1. Operating in as many CWTs as possible
- 2. Practicing pileups with MorseRunner, using previous FQP callsigns, daily for 5-6 weeks
- 3. Operating mobile in the GQP two weeks prior with 3,531 QSOs (I was very warmed up)
- 4. Band conditions were extraordinary, with 2 bands always wide open (40 and 20, or 20 and 15)



5. Having so many other mobiles created lots of interest (and kept my pileups a bit smaller and thus more manageable)


6. #1 - Melody did her usual great job driving and keeping us on schedule and safe

In this contest there are not many multipliers for in-state participants. The multipliers are states, provinces, and DX callsigns. By the end of this contest, each multiplier was worth 51 QSOs, which makes searching for them worthwhile. So, what I have recently started doing is operating SO2V and assisted with my IC-7610 to chase DX stations. I use the 2<sup>nd</sup> VFO and the N1MM spectrum display to look for workable DX multipliers. It can take a while to get the other station to correctly copy my callsign and then exchange the state and county but it sure does result in a larger score.

Below you find some screens shots showing the score summary, rates, and multipliers. If any of you have an inkling to get into mobile contesting, you won't be disappointed. I would be glad to help.




